The cottage on Cove Point is a small, charming, renovated, classic island cape house.

Upstairs are two bedrooms, 1 twin, 1 full, and 1 half bath. Downstairs has foldout queen in living room, 1 full bath, kitchen, foyer/mudroom. Outside deck has gas BBQ, ever changing views of the sea, lower Clarks Harbor across the cove, small islands to explore and Cape Sable lighthouse to the south. There are deer, pheasant, shore birds, herons, and hawks. Great for salt water kayaking and canoeing.



RATES: 700 USD per week + 300 USD deposit required.
Total has to be received two weeks in advance of check in.

Deposit will be returned after checkout.

DIRECTIONS:

Cape Sable Island is the southern tip of Nova Scotia.

From Halifax Airport south on Rte 103, 2 1/2 hours.

From Digby Ferry 1 3/4 hour via Rte 103.

From Yarmouth Ferry, 3/4 hour via Rte 103.

All to Rte 3 Barrington Passage, to Rte 330 over causeway.

Then route 330 to Lower Clarks Harbor you will see

Fishermen's Cove Restaurant on your left.

Then look right for first driveway along the cove.

No. 1241 Cove Point.



The island town of Clarks Harbor has grocery, laundry, bank, gas, and a library, etc.

Seafood can be purchased on the wharfs.

Cape Sable Island has miles of ocean beaches. It is considered the premier birding area for migratory and shore birds in eastern Canada.
